

NOTICE OF BOARD CONSIDERATION OF BYLAW

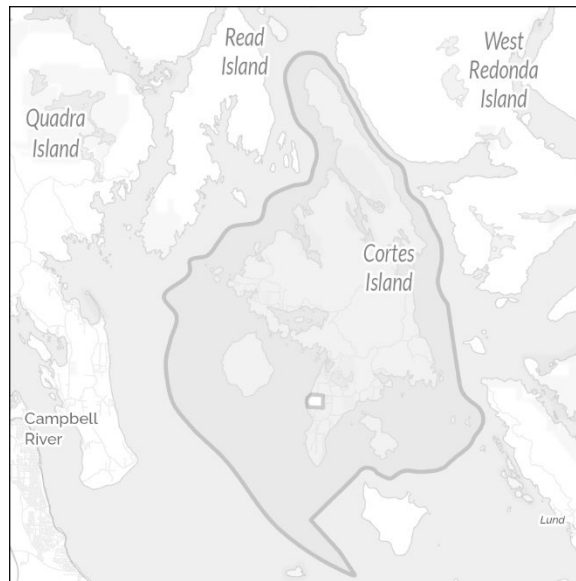
BYLAW NO. 509 – CORTES ISLAND ZONING BYLAW, 2002, Amendment No. 32

Notice is hereby given under Sections 464(3) and 467 of the *Local Government Act* that the Strathcona Regional District will consider First, Second and Third Readings and Final Adoption of Bylaw 509 during a regular Board meeting commencing at **12:30pm** on **September 25, 2024**.

Location: SRD Boardroom, 990 Cedar Street, Campbell River BC

Subject Area: All lands within Electoral Area B subject to the Cortes Island Zoning Bylaw as shown on Map 1 below.

Purpose: To propose zoning bylaw amendments to regulate the processing, bottling, or sale of bulk water. The bylaw proposes to prohibit bulk water processing, bottling and sales but specifically excludes receipt of water by parcels of land where supplemental water is required to enable private domestic, agricultural, commercial or industrial consumption as permitted by zoning.
