

APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION AS A NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTOR

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM

PERSONAL INFORMATION

- Print applicant's surname and given names in full.
- Complete this section if the applicant's name has changed since previously registering as a non-resident property elector.
- Print *either* the last 6 digits of the applicant's social insurance number *or* the applicant's birthdate. This information is required pursuant to the *Local Government Act*.

RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS

- Print the applicant's residential address including street number and name, city/town, postal code, and email.

MAILING ADDRESS

- If different from the residential address, print the applicant's mailing address including street number and name, city/town and postal code

PROPERTY FOR WHICH VOTING ENTITLEMENT IS BEING SOUGHT

- Print the street address or legal description of the applicant's real property in relation to which the applicant is registering. Applicant *must* attach satisfactory proof that he or she is entitled to register in relation to the real property for which voting entitlement is being sought (e.g., certificate of title, property tax notice, property assessment notice)
- If the land title registration of the real property in relation to which a person is registering under this section indicates that there is more than one individual who is the registered owner of the real property, you must complete and attach the "Non-Resident Property Elector Consent Form". The person may only register as a non-resident property elector with the written consent of those owners who, together with the person registering, constitute a majority of the owners of the property.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove both residency and identity are required.

SIGNATURES

- Applicant must declare that he or she meets all the requirements listed in this section to register as a non-resident property elector.
- Applicant must sign the application form in the presence of a witness.
- The witness to the applicant's signature must sign the application form.
- Print residential address of the witness. Not required if the witness is an election official.

ELECTION OFFICIAL USE

- If person is registering at a time of voting, 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove both residency and identity are required.
- If the person *does not* have documentation showing residency, 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) are still required and the person must make a solemn declaration as to their place of residence.
- The type of identification documents provided (not the numbers or other information on the documents) must be printed here.

- I am a Canadian citizen;
- I am age 18 or older today OR I will be 18 or older on general voting day for the election or assent voting;
- I have been a resident in B.C. for at least 6 months immediately before today;
- I have been the registered owner of real property identified above for at least 30 days immediately before today;
- The only persons who are registered owners of the real property identified above are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or any other trust;
- I am not entitled to register as a resident elector within the voting jurisdiction
- I have obtained the consent of a majority of the owners of the above-described property to be registered as the non-resident property elector for the property (see page 2);
- I am not currently registered as a non-resident property elector with respect to any other property within the voting jurisdiction; and
- I am not disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.
