QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as an electoral area director if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on October 17, 2026;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months at the time nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other law or enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, elected to or holding office.

EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Election Campaign Financing Act*, the expense limit for candidates during the campaign period for this election is \$6,161.89, and the third-party advertising limit is \$924.28
