Campbell River, BC - The Strathcona Regional District (SRD) was officially formed on February 15, 2008, when the then Comox Strathcona Regional District was split into the SRD and the Comox Valley Regional District. Over the last 10 years, the organization has grown and developed, while strengthening programs and expanding the list of services offered.

“2018 marks an exciting year for the SRD. Not only has the organization reached its 10-year anniversary, but it is entering an exciting growth phase. We have recently been awarded several large grants to drive strategic Board priorities, which will provide benefits across the region.
