



BYLAW NO. 105

A BYLAW TO AMEND SOIL DEPOSIT AND REMOVAL EXTENDED SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT BYLAW NO. 2106, 1998

WHEREAS the former Comox Strathcona Regional District has, by Bylaw No. 2106, established a service to control the deposit and removal of soil;

AND WHEREAS an establishing bylaw of the former Comox Strathcona Regional District that authorizes the operation of a service within all or part of the area comprising the Strathcona Regional District remains in force as an establishing bylaw of the Strathcona Regional District until amended or repealed;

AND WHEREAS the service established by Bylaw No. 2106 applies to portions of the Strathcona Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the Strathcona Regional District wishes to amend the provisions of the aforesaid Bylaw No. 2106;

AND WHEREAS the consent of at least 2/3 of the participants of the service has been obtained;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Amendments

1. Sections 2 and 3 of Bylaw No. 2106 are hereby deleted in their entirety and the following substituted therefor:

"Participating Area

2. *The participating area for the service is Electoral Area D (Oyster Bay-Buttle Lake).*

Service Area Boundaries

3. *The boundaries of the service area include all of the participating area."*

2. This bylaw may be cited for all purpose as Bylaw No. 105, being Soil Deposit and Removal Control Extended Service Establishment Bylaw 1998, Amendment No. 2.
