

STRATHCONA REGIONAL DISTRICT
BYLAW NO. 37

A bylaw to amend the regional district emergency preparedness (northern communities) plan service by renaming it as the Strathcona emergency program and by changing the apportionment for the service

WHEREAS the board adopted Bylaw No. 2733 being "Strathcona Emergency Program Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2733, 2004" on the 29th day of March 2005;

AND WHEREAS the board desires to amend the service establishment bylaw by renaming the service as "Strathcona Emergency Program" and also amending the apportionment to have all participants contribute based on converted values provided that the minimum amount any participant contributes is \$1000;

AND WHEREAS the bylaw requires updates to reflect current electoral area names and designations;

AND WHEREAS the electoral area directors of the participating electoral areas have given consent on behalf of the electors in writing to adoption of this bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the councils of the participating municipalities have given consent on behalf of the electors in writing to the adoption of this bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the Inspector of Municipalities has approved the adoption of this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the board of the Strathcona Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

Citation

1. This Bylaw No. 37 may be cited for all purposes as the "Strathcona Emergency Program Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2733, 2004, Amendment No. 1".

Amendment

2. Bylaw No. 2733 being "Regional District Emergency Preparedness (Northern Communities) Plan Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2733, 2004" is hereby amended by:

- (a) Replacing section 1 (citation), which reads:

"This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Regional District Emergency Preparedness (Northern Communities) Plan Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2733, 2004.""

with the following section 1 (citation):

"This Bylaw No. 2733 may be cited for all purposes as the "Strathcona Emergency Program Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2733, 2004."";

- (b) Replacing section 2 (service), which reads:

"The service established by this Bylaw is the Emergency Preparedness (Northern Communities) Plan Service (the "Service") for the purpose of establishing and operating an emergency preparedness plan for Electoral Areas 'D', 'G', 'H', 'I', 'J', the District of Campbell River, the Village of Gold River, the Village of Sayward, the Village of Tahsis and the Village of Zeballos."

With the following section 2 (service):

"The service established by this bylaw is the Strathcona Emergency Program (the "Service") for the purpose of establishing and operating an emergency preparedness plan for Electoral Area 'A' (Sayward – Kyuquot/Nootka), Electoral Area 'B' (Cortes), Electoral Area 'C' (Discovery Islands – Mainland Inlets) and Electoral Area 'D' (Oyster Bay – Buttle Lake), the City of Campbell River, the Village of Gold River, the Village of Sayward, the Village of Tahsis and the Village of Zeballos.";

(c) Replacing section 3 (boundaries), which reads:

"The boundaries of the Service area are coterminous with the boundaries of Electoral Areas 'D', 'G', 'H', 'I', 'J', the District of Campbell River, the Village of Gold River, the Village of Sayward, the Village of Tahsis and the Village of Zeballos (the "Service Area")."

with the following section 3 (boundaries):

"The boundaries of the extended service are coterminous with the boundaries of Electoral Area 'A' (Sayward – Kyuquot/Nootka), Electoral Area 'B' (Cortes), Electoral Area 'C' (Discovery Islands – Mainland Inlets) and Electoral Area 'D' (Oyster Bay – Buttle Lake), the City of Campbell River, the Village of Gold River, the Village of Sayward, the Village of Tahsis and the Village of Zeballos." and

(d) Replacing section 4 (participating area), which reads:

"The "Participating Area" is Electoral Areas 'D', 'G', 'H', 'I' and 'J', the District of Campbell River, the Village of Gold River, the Village of Sayward, the Village of Tahsis and the Village of Zeballos."

with the following section 4 (participating area):

"The "Participating Area" is Electoral Area 'A' (Sayward – Kyuquot/Nootka), Electoral Area 'B' (Cortes), Electoral Area 'C' (Discovery Islands – Mainland Inlets) and Electoral Area 'D' (Oyster Bay – Buttle Lake), the City of Campbell River, the Village of Gold River, the Village of Sayward, the Village of Tahsis and the Village of Zeballos."

(e) Replacing section 6 (maximum requisition), which reads:

"In accordance with section 800.1(1)(e) of the Local Government Act, the maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the cost of the Service is the amount that may be raised by a property value tax rate of 3¢ per one thousand (\$1,000) dollars applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements for regional district purposes."

with the following section 6 (maximum requisition):

"In accordance with section 800.1(1)(e) of the *Local Government Act*, the maximum amount that may be requisitioned for the cost of the service 3¢ is per \$1,000.00 applied to the net taxable value of land and improvement within the service area";

(f) Replacing section 7 (apportionment), which reads:

"In accordance with section 804 of the Local Government Act, the annual cost of the Service shall be apportioned among the Participating Areas on the basis set out in section (6) provided that the maximum amount that will be apportioned to the District of Campbell River is \$25,000."

with the following section 7 (apportionment):

- "(1) For the year 2010 the annual costs of the services shall be apportioned to each participant as follows:
 - a) The City of Campbell River will pay 48% of the service costs;
 - b)
 - (i) The remaining participants will pay 52% of the services costs that shall be apportioned on the basis of the converted value of land and improvements for hospital purposes, provided that the minimum contribution is \$1,000;
 - (ii) If it is required to apply the minimum of \$1,000 to any participant, the remaining amount will then be apportioned among those remaining participants on the basis applied of the converted value of land and improvements for hospital purposes in those areas.
- (2)
 - (i) For the year 2011 and every year thereafter the annual costs of the service shall be apportioned to each participant on the basis of converted value of land and improvements for hospital purposes in those areas provided that the minimum contribution is \$1,000;
 - (ii) If it is required to apply the minimum of \$1,000 to any participant, the remaining amount will then be apportioned among those remaining participants on the basis applied of the converted value of land and improvements for hospital purposes in those areas."

(g) Replacing section 8 (service review), which reads:

"All aspects of the "Emergency Preparedness (Northern Communities) Plan Service" shall be reviewed every five years, with the first review occurring in 2009."

with the following:


"All aspects of the "Strathcona Emergency Program" shall be reviewed every five years, with the first review occurring in 2009."
