



BYLAW NO. 67

A BYLAW TO REPEAL REGIONAL DISTRICT FIREWORKS REGULATION BYLAW NO. 1971, 1998

WHEREAS an establishing bylaw of the former Comox Strathcona Regional District that authorizes the operation of a service within all or part of the area comprising the Strathcona Regional District remains in force as an establishing bylaw of the Strathcona Regional District until amended or repealed;

AND WHEREAS the Strathcona Regional District has, by Bylaw No. 35, repealed Fireworks Regulation Extended Service Conversion Bylaw No. 2002, 1997;

AND WHEREAS the regulations established by Regional District Fireworks Regulation Bylaw No. 1971, 1998 are no longer enforceable;

AND WHEREAS the Strathcona Regional District wishes to repeal the aforesaid Bylaw No. 1971;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Repeal

1. Regional District Fireworks Regulation Bylaw No. 1971, 1998 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Effective Date

2. This bylaw shall take effect 30 days after its adoption.




