



BYLAW NO. 145

A BYLAW TO REPEAL ELECTORAL AREA 'G' ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SERVICE BYLAW NO. 2420, 2002

WHEREAS the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District has, by Bylaw No. 2420, established a service to provide economic development within Electoral Area G;

AND WHEREAS a bylaw of the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District that authorizes the operation of a service within all or part of the area comprising the Strathcona Regional District remains in force as a bylaw of the Strathcona Regional District until amended or repealed;

AND WHEREAS the Comox-Strathcona Regional District was divided into the Comox Valley Regional District and the Strathcona Regional District by letters patent effective February 15, 2008;

AND WHEREAS Electoral Area G of the Comox-Strathcona Regional District was designated as part of Electoral Area A (Kyuquot/Nootka-Sayward) of the Strathcona Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the Strathcona Regional District wishes to repeal the aforesaid Bylaw No. 2420;

AND WHEREAS the consent of at least 2/3 of the participants of the service has been obtained in accordance with s.802 of the *Local Government Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Repeal

1. Electoral Area 'G' Economic Development Service Bylaw No. 2420, 2002 adopted by the Comox-Strathcona Regional District on March 25, 2002 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Effective Date

2. This bylaw shall take effect on December 31, 2012.

Citation

3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Bylaw No. 145, being Electoral Area 'G' Economic Development Service Bylaw No. 2420, Repeal Bylaw 2012.


