



BYLAW NO. 290

A BYLAW TO REPEAL HOUSE NUMBERING REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO THE SAYWARD VALLEY AREA

WHEREAS the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District was authorized by supplementary letters patent dated January 13, 1976 to undertake the function of house numbering;

AND WHEREAS the said house numbering function was, by Bylaw No. 2142, converted to a service to be operated under the authority of an establishing bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District, by Bylaw No. 2157, enacted regulations requiring the owners of property to affix and display house numbers in accordance with the provisions of the bylaw;

AND WHEREAS a bylaw of the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District that authorizes the operation of a service within all or part of the area comprising the Strathcona Regional District remains in force until amended or repealed;

AND WHEREAS the division of the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District into the Strathcona Regional District and Comox Valley Regional District has resulted in Bylaw No. 2157 having application only in the Sayward Valley;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board wishes to repeal the aforesaid Bylaw No. 2157;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Repeal

1. Bylaw No. 2157, being Regional District House Numbering Regulation Bylaw 1999, as adopted by the Comox-Strathcona Regional District on the 28th day of June, 1999 is hereby repealed in its entirety.


2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Bylaw No. 290, being Regional District House Numbering Regulation Repeal Bylaw 2017.


