

BYLAW NO. 589

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE BOUNDARIES FOR THE SOUTH CORTES ISLAND FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE

WHEREAS the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District has, by Bylaw No. 1263, established a service to provide fire protection for part of Cortes Island;

AND WHEREAS an establishing bylaw of the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District that authorizes the operation of a service within all or part of the area comprising the Strathcona Regional District remains in force as an establishing bylaw of the Strathcona Regional District until amended or repealed;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board wishes to amend the boundaries for the South Cortes fire protection service to include properties in the Tiber Bay area;

AND WHEREAS a petition of affected property owners has been certified as sufficient in accordance with s.337 of the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the consent of at least 2/3 of the participants has been obtained pursuant to s.349 of the *Local Government Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Amendment

1. Schedule 'A' to Bylaw No. 1263 is hereby amended by adding those properties shown outlined in bold on Appendix 'A', attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

Citation

2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Bylaw No. 589, being South Cortes Island Fire Protection Services and Facilities Service Establishment Bylaw 1990, Amendment No. 6.



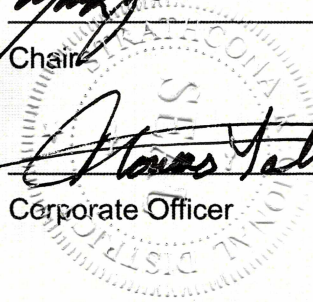
