



BYLAW NO. 594

A BYLAW TO REPEAL THE CORTES ISLAND SOLID WASTE CAPITAL RESERVE FUND BYLAW AND TRANSFER THE EXISTING RESERVES FOR OPERATING PURPOSES

WHEREAS the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District has, by Bylaw No. 911, established a reserve fund to be used for the acquisition, maintenance or renewal of capital works, land, machinery or equipment in connection with the solid waste service on Cortes Island;

AND WHEREAS the Comox-Strathcona Regional District was divided into the Comox Valley Regional District and the Strathcona Regional District by letters patent effective February 15, 2008;

AND WHEREAS a bylaw of the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District that applies within all or part of the area comprising the Strathcona Regional District remains in force as a bylaw of the Strathcona Regional District until amended or repealed;

AND WHEREAS Electoral Area I of the Comox-Strathcona Regional District has been designated as Electoral Area B (Cortes Island) of the Strathcona Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the Strathcona Regional District wishes to repeal the aforesaid Bylaw No. 911 by adoption of this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Repeal

1. Bylaw 911 adopted by the Comox-Strathcona Regional District on December 11, 1986 and cited as Electoral Area I Refuse Disposal, Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Transfer of Reserve Funds

2. Upon adoption of this bylaw, the balance of funds in the said reserve fund shall be transferred for use as operating funds in connection with the management of solid waste within Electoral Area B.

Effective Date

3. This bylaw shall become effective at the time of its adoption.

Citation

4. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Bylaw No. 594, being Cortes Island Solid Waste Capital Reserve Fund Repeal Bylaw 2025.
