

BYLAW NO. 597

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE PROVISION OF A LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANNING SERVICE IN ELECTORAL AREA D (OYSTER BAY-BUTTLE LAKE)

WHEREAS the Regional District may, pursuant to the *Local Government Act*, operate any service that it considers necessary or desirable for all or a part of the Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the Strathcona Regional District wishes to establish a liquid waste management planning service for Electoral Area D (Oyster Bay-Buttle Lake);

AND WHEREAS participating area consent has been obtained pursuant to Section 342 of the *Local Government Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Service Established

1. There is hereby established a service to be known as the Electoral Area D liquid waste management planning service.

Description of Service

2. The service authorized by this bylaw includes coordination, research and analysis in relation to liquid waste management.

Participating Area

3. The participating area for the service is Electoral Area D (Oyster Bay-Buttle Lake).

Service Area Boundaries

4. The boundaries of the service area include the entirety of Electoral Area D.

Cost Recovery

5. The annual net cost of the service shall be recovered by one or more of the following methods;
 - a) property value taxes imposed in accordance with Division 2 of Part 11 of the *Local Government Act*;
 - b) revenues received by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise;
 - c) revenues raised by other means authorized by the *Local Government Act* or other Act.

Annual Limit on Requisition

6. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the service is the equivalent of \$0.05 per \$1,000 of the net taxable value of land and improvements in the service area.

Effective Date

7. This bylaw will become effective on January 1, 2026.

Citation

8. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Bylaw No. 597, being Electoral Area D Liquid Waste Management Planning Service Establishing Bylaw 2025.


